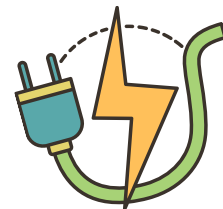


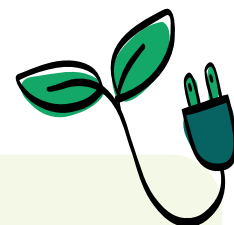

Make Energy-Efficient Home



The Challenge

Make your home more Energy-Efficient.



Did you know that

When you take small steps to reduce energy waste, you lower your energy bills and reduce your environmental impact. Simple actions like switching to LED bulbs, sealing drafts, and unplugging unused devices can make a big difference.



Put some **"Save Energy" stickers** around



Steps

1. Identify three incandescent bulbs in your home and replace them with energy-efficient LED bulbs within the next week.
2. Check for drafts around windows and doors. Seal at least two gaps to prevent heat loss in winter and reduce air conditioning needs in summer.
3. Look for electronics in your home that are plugged in but not in use. Unplug at least five devices in a week.
4. Open blinds during the day to let in natural light instead of using electricity.
5. If possible, plant a small tree or place potted plants near windows to provide cooling shade in summer.



The challenge is met when you complete at least three of the steps and take action to reduce energy use in your home.
