GOAL OF THE
ACTION/PROJECT

Introduction to climate and the basic definitions. Participants/ students learn about climate, weather, related phenomenon, and climate zones. The objective is to educate young people about climate and raise awareness about climate change. This activity is proposed to youth workers/ educators working with young people in a class or in non-formal education setting

DESCRIPTION

Each participant receives a printed bingo table. They need to find answers to the questions by looking them up in the Factbook and other digital resources. The game ends when the first person fills in all the boxes and says BINGO! The facilitator/ teacher needs to check the answers. If they are correct the person wins. If not, the game continues until the next person says BINGO!

At the end of this activity, ask your participants the following questions:

- What questions did you have to look up? Which ones were you not able to answer yourselves?
- Was there a question you found particularly challenging?
- What did you learn for the first time today?
- Did anything surprise you or did you find anything particularly interesting?

Educate on basic terms related to climate and weather and raise awareness about climate change among young people in a long run.

DESCRIPTION

The objective is to understand the difference between the definition of weather and climate, and to better understand the root of the words. Learn to relate the word 'climate' with other terms and topics.

The facilitator/ teacher gives the participants post-its of two different colours. On the first one, they need to write terms related to the root of the word "climate" and on the other any terms related to the definition of the word "weather". The participants stick the post-its on two flipchart papers that are in front of them. After everyone has finished the facilitator/ teacher reads the words and discusses with the participants.

Tips for facilitator

Separate the participants into two groups, assign one with 'climate' and the other with 'weather'. Have a flipchart in front of all participants and have one column on it for each term. The 'climate' group should have one colour post-its and write down as many words, ideas, phrases, descriptions they relate with the term, and paste them in the respective column on the flipchart. The 'weather' group should have post-its of a different colour and do the same for their term. Following this activity, each group should present their associations, and a group discussion on the differences between climate and weather should follow

The GreenWave Festival is an alternative celebration that promotes green values, ecology, alternative proposals, and solutions for a fair green transition. It aims to engage the community, foster discussions on various issues, promote environmental awareness, and advocate for a responsible, green economy that benefits both people and the planet. The festival operates without government financial support, relying on self-financing and the voluntary contributions of organizers and volunteers.

DESCRIPTION

The GreenWave Festival is an annual event in Thessaloniki, Greece, organized by the Ecological Movement of Thessaloniki in collaboration with other organizations, networks, and informal groups in the city. Since its inception in 2011, the festival has grown, attracting more participants each September. It serves as a platform for people to freely cooperate, discuss critical issues, communicate, take action, and address local challenges related to survival, environment, solidarity, human rights, and democracy.

Art and Exhibitions: Artistic installations and exhibitions that convey messages related to ecology, sustainability, and environmental awareness.

A four-year initiative, undertaken by four Swiss and seven Bulgarian partners, including the Ministry of Agriculture and Food, centers on nine Natura 2000 zones in the Western and Central Balkan Range. The project aims to integrate nature protection and rural development for a mutually beneficial outcome. BBF, a key partner, focuses on communication, civil society engagement, nurturing future conservation leaders, and developing the "For the Nature" Coalition.

GOAL OF THE
ACTION/PROJECT

The initiative "Youth 4 Nature: Ενημέρωση και κινητοποίηση νέων για το περιβάλλον" aims to inform and actively mobilize Greek youth concerning environmental issues. It seeks to empower young people in the Greek university community to acquire knowledge and motivation for a more sustainable lifestyle while respecting the environment.

DESCRIPTION

"Youth 4 Nature" is a collaborative effort between AIESEC Greece (www.aiesec.gr) and WWF Greece (www.wwf.gr), recognizing the need to educate and engage young people on environmental issues. The initiative focuses on raising awareness among Greek university students about environmental topics, including Climate Action, Life Below Water, and Life on Land. In January 2019, the project welcomed six Global Volunteers from abroad who worked towards these objectives. These volunteers designed awareness campaigns and interventions targeting Greek university students. Additionally, young people from eight different Greek universities actively engaged with key environmental issues such as "green careers," environmental footprint, and energy conservation. The initiative is conducted in collaboration with the company "European Trust" as a supporting partner of AIESEC Greece, which covered the participation expenses of the volunteers.

Awareness Campaigns: "Youth 4 Nature" conducts awareness campaigns, workshops, and interventions to educate university students about environmental topics.

Global Volunteers: International volunteers collaborate with Greek youth to design and implement environmental initiatives.

Online Platforms: The initiative maintains a presence on Facebook to keep participants informed and engaged.

The Zero Food Waste project is an integrated, educational, interactive, and informative platform that aims to promote the principles of circular and social economy. It focuses on utilizing and reusing food waste to transform it into high-value products for various sectors of the Greek economy, such as the chemical industry, food technology, cosmetics production, soil improvement, and energy

DESCRIPTION

Zero Food Waste is a comprehensive initiative that focuses on reducing food waste and promoting circular and social economy principles in Greece. It involves collaboration between Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), the Greek Agricultural Organization "Dimitra" (ELGO-DIMITRA), and the Greek Scouts (SEP). The project aims to disseminate research findings related to food waste among different target groups, including children, youth, future scientists, and the wider society. It also includes practical initiatives such as the operation of a thematic park dedicated to circular economy, workshops, and communication campaigns to raise awareness about sustainable practices.

The aim is to avoid water pollution from household products that normally contain chemicals, and which also have an impact on our health.

DESCRIPTION

Homemade cleaners are a great alternative to store-bought chemicals. They are less likely to cause harm or irritation, they are environmentally friendly, easy to make, and you know what is in them! You can also control the strength of the cleaners as you control the ingredients. Though we can find "green" cleaning products in the store, they may still contain harsh irritants. Making your own cleaners at home eliminates this risk.

DIY All-Purpose Cleaner Recipe

- 1/4 cup vinegar
- 12-20 drops essential oil
- 1 tsp castile or phosphorous-free dish soap or washing soda
- 2 cups boiled or distilled water
- Fill cleaning spray bottle with 2-4 cups (see the website for variations on this recipe based on strength desired) distilled or boiled (cooled) water.
- Add all other ingredients. Shake well.

Within the framework of zero waste project, the target is to bring all the waste collected in households to recycling and economy. The project has established citizen incentive system through bringing the waste back. Main motto of the project is "bring your waste, collect points, spend at shopping".

DESCRIPTION

2 specially equipped vehicles were placed in two points to create collection points for the citizens. In total, number has reached 15 in a week. These vehicles who were equipped with solar energy systems, served as both waste collection point and communication point which displayed informative videos about zero waste.

By going to the highly frequented areas with major ecological issues, the facilitator posts or circulates on the site and calls or is questioned by the passing public. It is an innovative technique which makes it possible to raise awareness among a so-called "non-captive" public, that is to say people who did not come to participate in a nature animation.

By relying on simple animation tools, adapted and adaptable according to the atmosphere, the type of audience and the territory, the facilitator makes himself available to people encountered. It is at the service of visitors to the site: getting to know them, getting closer to their questions through varied teaching approaches. On a chosen theme, it involves staging the theme through a scenario that will allow us to challenge, present the natural site and its management, understand the protection issues and transmit the behavioral messages linked to the fragility of the site.
